Joseph McGurl is one of America's most prominent contemporary landscape painters. He has been designated a Living Master by the Art Renewal Center, elected to the Guild of Boston Artists, was a Copley Master with the Copley Society of Boston, was a fellow with the American Society of Marine Artists and is a signature member of the Plein Air Painters of America. Among his many awards are the Guild of Boston Artists Gold Medallion; the Art Renewal Center's International Salon two First Place in Landscape awards, Plein Air Magazine award, American Fine Art Magazine Award of Excellence, Rehs Award, and a Purchase Award; Best of Show and Patron's Choice at the Laguna Plein Air Painting Invitational; Two Patron's Choice Awards at the Coors Western Art shows; Best Group of Paintings at the Salmagundi Club American Masters Show; the Boldbrush Award; and the Copley Society's the John Singleton Copley Award given for Artistic Achievement.
